


200-300 events every year local organizers, mostly small associations


#### **GOALS:**

# Sewing skill and the Singer sewing machine have been inherited from mothers to daughters in the Berg family







Winners: preschool group (6 yrs) from Tampere, who adopted a part of a fortification in the Adopt a Monument program




