

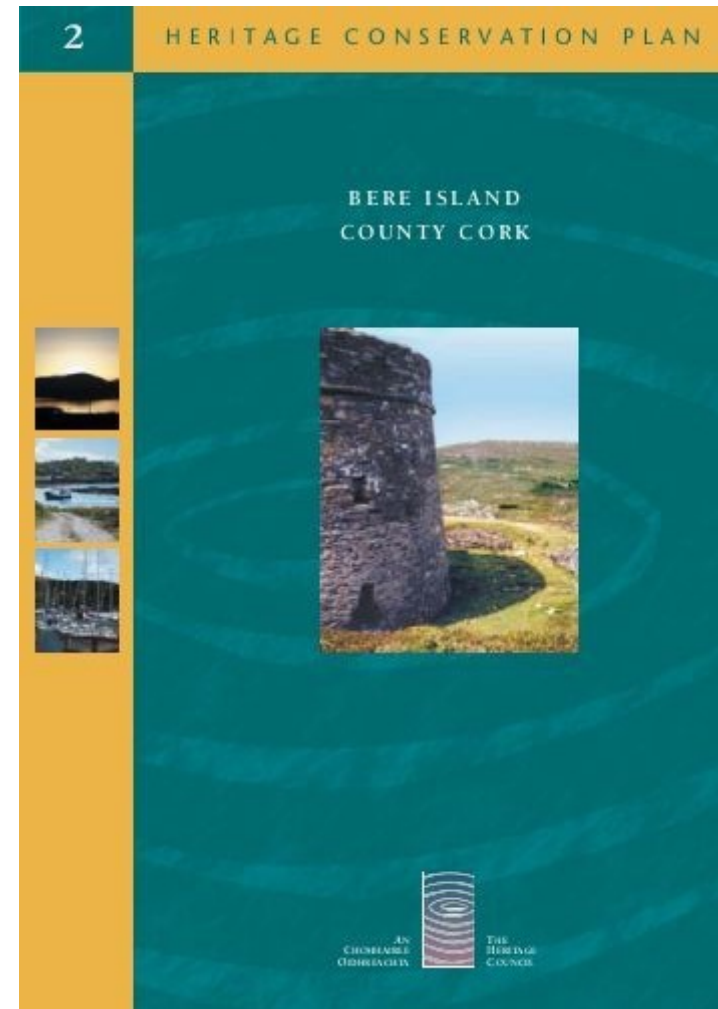

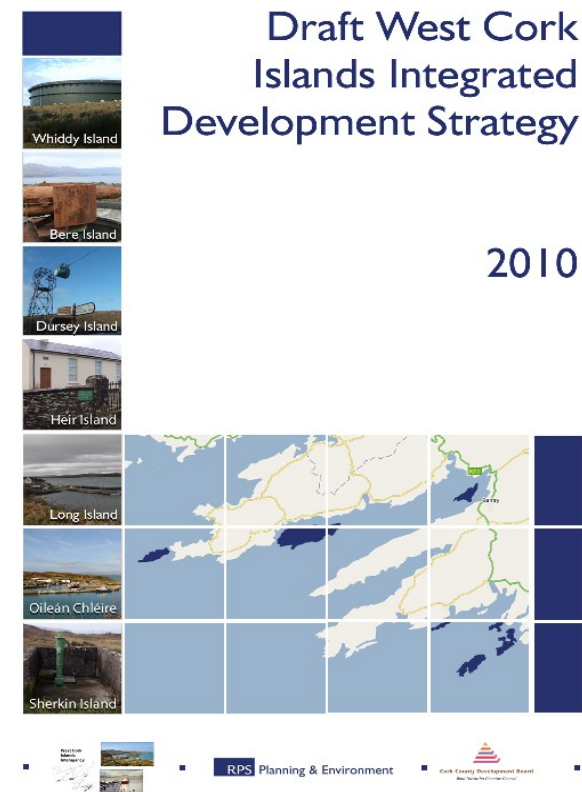
CONSERVATION PLAN

Military History

- Vikings
- Martello Towers built in 1805 to defend against the French.
- Construction started in 1897 to defend Fort Berehaven.
- Potential to be a major tourist attraction in West Cork.



ARCHIVE PHOTOS

- Over 700 old photos were collected as part of Culture 2000 project.
- These are added to on an ongoing basis.
- Priority now is to source old military photos.
- Plans to publish a photographic book.
- Ed White film of island life in 1950s & 1960s.

- Heritage Centre – regular exhibitions to promote island heritage, artifact collection.

AQUACULTURE

- 3 licenses granted in 2011 to cultivate oysters, seaweed & scallops.
- First crop of 60000 juvenile oysters purchased in 2012.
- Working with commercial seaweed enterprise on island.
- Commercial Mussel farm
- Scallops are famous



AGRICULTURE

- 4 islanders passed their beekeeping exams.
- Pig rearing is back.
- Sheep and cattle
- Rare Breeds
- Plans for commercial food production unit.
- EIP application



FOOD PRODUCTION

- Cookery lessons.
- Food production courses – bread making, fish smoking, fish filleting & butchery.
- Plans for a unique Island brand.
- Farm tours



ENERGY

- In 2011 a survey found Bere Island used 110,000 litres of heating oil, 65,000kg of coal, 150,000 litres of fuel for vehicles, 140,000 litres of fuel for ferries, 95 households & 19 businesses.
- IRDA project with Denmark
- Smilegov Project
- Master plan developed



ENERGY - cont

- Short term (1-5 yrs):
Increase of domestic solar hot water. Insulate houses.
Small scale wind installations
Increase usage of wood & pellet fuel & plant biomass
- Medium Term (5-10yrs)
Install 500kW wind turbine
Increase biomass planting
Investigate electric vehicle usage
- Long Term (10-20yrs)
Increase wind production
Install tidal/wave production
Export to national grid



WASTE MANAGEMENT

- Recycling Centre.
- Waste collection.
- Island school – Green Flags
- Island has won the Tidy Island Award for 11 consecutive years.
- Plans to power centre with renewable energy .



LANDSCAPE

- Annual tree planting initiative.
- Native Irish trees encouraged ash, alder, oak, rowan, whitethorn.
- Winner of European Landscape Award from the Council of Europe in 2013.
- Eradication of Gunnera & Japanese knotweed & Rhododendron



WORKING WITH YOUTH

- Annual summer camps, swim week & sailing/Kayaking week.
- School produced a book “We Are Writers”.
- Heritage events for schools in Beara.
- Nature walks and seashore walks
- Annual Islands soccer and football
- Entrepreneurship in school



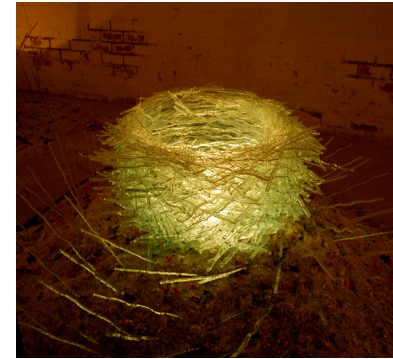
TOURISM
